The following is a fact sheet on the status of the demands issued by the Student Senate last week.

1. Calendar--Father Yanitelli agreed to reopen negotiations on next year's calendar.
2. Student contract-- It has been withdrawn and turned over to the Student Personnel Office for revisions.
3. Kilfoyle--Professor Kilfoyle has been offered a contract for next year. He is not considering it until all the student demands are met.

The student senate makes it clear that it will not accept the administration responses to the three issues until it has it in writing from Father Yanitelli.

4. Student voice and vote--The student senate has accepted the Pontrelli-Pegolotti proposal as an answer to the demand contingent upon a resolution by the Saint Peter's College Board of Trustees also agreeing to it. The administration is agreed on the proposal. The board action should come this week.
5. Haessler--Father Yanitelli stands by his original statement to abide by the AAUP decision in the case. The student senate rejects the answer and favors Dr. Pontrelli's proposal that Professor Haessler be given a two-year leave of absence to pursue his graduate studies and then return to Saint Peter's. The administration has rejected the proposal.

Paul Lamb reaffirmed his determination to continue the strike until all demands are met.
