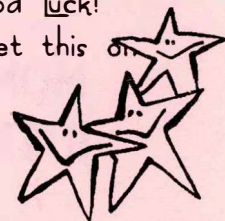
To the cast and crew,

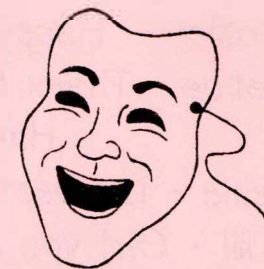
