VISITING PROFESSOR....Centennial Mini-Professor Bernard Lonergan, S.J., one of the leading philosophers and theologians in the Americas, will begin his campus visit at 10 A.M. January 17 at a seminar in Pope Auditorium open to the faculty and student body. At 2:30 P.M. that day there will be a student forum in the faculty lounge in McDermott Hall and this will be followed at 4:30 P.M. by a reception sponsored by the Departments of Theology, Philosophy and Mathematics in McIntyre Lounge open to the entire college community. At 10 A.M. on January 18 Father Lonergan will address theology and philosophy majors and Honors Program members on the theme "Why I Wrote Insight and Method in Theology." The lecture will be given in Dinneen 327 followed by a coffee hour in the Fountain Room. His public lecture, "Religious Commitment" will be at 8 o'clock that night in Dinneen Auditorium. On the final day of his visit, January 19, Father Lonergan will take part in a roundtable discussion in Pope 314, open to students and faculty. At 5 P.M. there will be a concluding session with Father Lonergan and those students and teachers who have taken part in the program.

FRIGID SPRING....Professors Konstantyn Sawczuk and James Folliard of the Department of History, will give a new course on the Cold War during the Spring Semester.

ACCOUNTING TOPIC....Mr. Gregory P. Cinnella, associate professor of accountancy recently addressed the Accounting Club at Bergen Community College on the accountancy program at Saint Peter's for students from two-year community colleges.

GETTING CLOSER....Father Ryan scored another victory in his battle to gain state aid for independent colleges last Wednesday when Governor William T. Cahill announced his support of the plan adopted by the State Board of Higher Education. On that same day Father Ryan met with State Senator Harry L. Sears, chairman of the special legislative committee on taxation, who promised aid for independent colleges and their students will be included in his report to the legislature due February 1. Father Ryan also discussed the aid plan with State Treasurer Joseph McCrane, Budget Director Walter Wexler, Chancellor Ralph Dungan, and Thomas Truitt, budget director for the board of higher education. Completing Father Ryan's week was an appearance before the State Board of Higher Education on Friday and a conference with Senate Minority Leader J. Edward Crabile. He has scheduled meetings this week with Hudson's State Senators William V. Musto and James P. Dugan.

CENTENNIAL OFFERING....A special course "The Literature and Culture of Cuba" will be offered by the Department of Modern Languages during the Spring Semester. As a highlight of the course the college's Cuban students will present the opera Cecilia Valdes by Gonzalo Roig on April 14, 15 and 16. In the fall the department will offer "The Literature and Culture of Puerto Rico" and as part of it our Puerto Rican students will perform in the drama La Carreta by Rene Marques on November 17, 18, and 19. Both courses will have evening sessions, featuring distinguished speakers, open to the public. Professor Luisa de la Torre will teach both courses.

HOLIDAY SPIRIT....A pre-Christmas liturgy for the entire college community will be held at 12 o'clock noon Wednesday in McDermott Chapel.
